

Dear Senator \_\_\_\_\_,

Thank you for your willingness to serve the public.

As a voter and taxpayer of the State of Florida, I respectfully ask you to support **Mallory's Law**, a proposed tough, Drunk Driving Child Endangerment Law that adds **"Double" the fines and penalties** associated with DUI/OUI offense while transporting a child, as well as a **Mandatory Child Abuse Charge** if the child being transported is injured or killed.

This proposal is being provided by the friends, family & supporters of the **Justice 4 Mallory Foundation**. The Foundation was developed in response to the tragic loss of Mallory Lee Homer, a beautiful 10 year old girl on December 27, 2006 in a fatal car crash. Mallory's life was cut short by the actions of her negligent parents, who forced her into a car after a night of heavy partying. Mallory's only fault that day was that she had no other choice but to enter that vehicle with her intoxicated parents.

It has been over a year, and Mallory's father, the driver of the vehicle, has not been formally charged. The Bradford County Sheriff's Department has not even completed the toxicology test.

Florida's current laws regarding a drunk driving offense with children in the vehicle is currently a maximum 9 months in jail, fines of \$500 to \$1,000 and a maximum of "50" hours of community service. (Florida Law 316.193 (3) & (4), 775.082, 775.083 & 775.084)

Is a child's life in the State of Florida only worth "9" months and up to \$1500 dollars?

**The highlights of this proposed legislation are as follows:**

- Double the current fines for a standard DWI or OUI offense.
- Double the current jail sentences (Minimum 48 hours for first offense).
- Mandatory 100 hours of community service benefiting children.
- Mandatory Parenting Class.
- Mandatory Child Abuse charge if a child transported is killed or injured.

I encourage you to sponsor this important legislation by introducing a bill in the Senate. Please use the power entrusted to you by the voters of the Great State of Florida and support this tougher Drunk Driving Child Endangerment Law.
